Dr. YEUNG SHIU CHUEN.

(REGISTERED DENTIST)

One of the most prominent dentists in Hongkong is Dr. Yeung Shiu Chuen. He is a native of Chungshan District, Kwangtung Province, and was born in Macao in 1878. He was bred up in Hongkong, where he pursued his Chinese Studies in missionary and other schools for many years. Later, he turned his course to English studies. Deprived of the loving care of his mother at the age of sixteen, Dr. Yeung was compelled to earn his own living. When he was nineteen, he worked as an apprentice under Dr. Tsui Sion Ting, who was a famous dentist at that time. Three years later, he had the opportunity of continuing his studies in the Shun-lai-kwan Railway College. This was soon ended when the uprising of Boxers in 1900. He returned to the south and worked under Dr. Tsui, the dentist.

In 1906, he started his own practice in Hongkong. His skill and good-work was soon commended by most of the inhabitants. He was offered to a contract by Lt. Con. F. Gordon Hall of the Royal Army Medical Corps to consult all dental cases among the army. In 1914, he was licensed by the Hongkong Government as a Registered Dentist, and in 1915 he obtained a diploma from the Shanghai America Dental College, Shanghai, (U.S.A.)

Dr. Yeung is a man of broad sympathies, and every good cause finds him a willing supporter. He was Vice-chairman of China Home Missionary Association, Hongkong Branch; Standing Committee of Diocesan of Victoria; Vice-chairman of Hongkong Chinese Christian Union; Chairman of Hongkong Harbour Mission; Member of St. Stephen's Church Vestry; Treasurer of St. Paul's Church Vestry; Vice-chairman of Young Men Christian Association, Hongkong; Committee of Physical Department, Y.M.C.A.; Director of a free-school under the management of Y.M.C.A.; Committee of St. Paul's Girls' School; Director of Tai Kong Newspaper & Co., Ltd.; Committee of Hongkong Tenant Protection Association; Chairman of Chinese Swimming Association; Chairman of Chinese Bathing Club; Founder and Chairman of Anti-Mul-tan Society, Hongkong; Chairman of Fan Hing Christian Association, and manager of a monthly magazine issued by that association; President of Pokshan Kong Yick Association, Hongkong; and Chairman of Pokshan Home Police Maintenance Association.

At present, he is standing committee of St. Paul's Church Vestry; Reader of Diocesan of Victoria; committee of Chungshan Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong; Member of a committee taking charge of rice-affairs of the Chungshan Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong; Executive committee of Anti-Mul-tan Society, Hongkong; Vice-chairman of Fan Hing Christian Association; Vice-chairman of China Home Missionary Association, Hongkong Branch; Director of Hongkong Chinese Christian Union; and committee of Pok-shan Kong Yick Association, Hongkong.

Married in 1905, Dr. Yeung has eleven children and all of them are well educated in local schools.
