

Mr. Ma Kwok Ying, native of Toishan District; Kwangtung Province, was born in 1901.

He obtained a thorough education from the Provincial Normal School of Toishan, and when he graduated from the institute in 1924, he returned to his native village and initiated the Lui Tung School. Hitherto he has been Permanent Director of the school.

Late in winter of the same year, Mr. Ma came to Hongkong and established the Kwong Jip Lung, an imports and exports agent.

His late father, Mr. Ma King Tin, who was a prominent merchant in Canada, zealous patriot and helped a great part in the building of the Chinese Republic. Mr. Ma Kwok Ying himself is a faithful nationalist and he followed the foot-prints of his father. He has repleted his service to the Chinese Government.

He is a man of broad sympathy and every good cause finds him a willing supporter. The is the founder of the Ma's Alumni Association in Toishan; originator of the Lui Tung Library in his native village; member of a committee taking charge of the Property of the Toishan Guild, Canton; Hon. Director of the Nam Chong College, Hongkong; Director of the Toishan Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong; and director of the Sze-Yap Steamship Co., Ltd., Hongkong.
