Mr. TSE YU CHUEN.

One of the most prominent personages in the commercial sphere of Hongkong is Mr. Tse Yu Chuen. He is a native of Pun-U District, Kwangtung Province and was born in 1899. Having attained a good knowledge in Chinese literature, he entered the St. Joseph's College at the early age of eleven. He remained there until 1914, when Hongkong was heavily effected by the World War, then Mr. Tse returned to Canton. He came back to the Colony in the following year and continued his studies in the St. Paul's College. Two years later, he graduated from the institute and entered the business field.

He started as accountant in the Hongkong Trading Co., and later he was sent to the branch office in Shanghai holding the same post. As that position was not the intrinsic destination of Mr. Tse, so he returned to the Colony in 1925 and employed under the Melchers & Co., one of the most outstanding business houses in the city. At the beginning, he was but chief clerk and chief Book keeper of the Import Department. He worked on honestly and eagerly, discharging duties to every satisfaction. For ten years, he stuck fast in the position and in 1935 he was promoted as Compradore of the firm.

His experience, courtesy and industrious management endear him to all his business associates and friends.

Mr. Tse is publicly known for his social activities. He has been a member of the committee of the South China Athletic Association and Hon. Secretary of the Chinese Bathing Club, and executive Committee of the Chinese Athletic Federation. He is member of the Chinese Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong; Chinese Merchants' Association; and Pun-U Association.
