Mr. LEE CHI CHUNG.

Mr. Loo Cho Chung is the eldest sen of the late Mr. Lee Yok Tong, one of the most prominent personages of llongkong. He is a native of Toishan District, Kwangtung Province, born in 1882.

He was taught in a school in his native village till he was seventeen years old, and then he went to Canton and acquired practical knowledge in the Electrical Power Co., Ltd., which was initiated by his father.

He proceeded to Japan in the following year and learned the craft of military - training.

At the end of the Ch'ing Dynasty when the late Dr. Sun Yat Sen started revolution, Mr. Lee, who is an enthusiastic nationalist joined into the party. In 1901, he became a member of the Kwangung Independent Federal Association, Yokohama, which was organized by Dr. C. W. Wang. Two years later, when the late Dr. Sun Yat Sen established the Revolutionary Military Training School in Tokyo, Japan, Mr. Lee was one of the members of that institution.

He was under the instruction of Dr. Sun, and returned to Hongkong in 1905 to ally with these revolutionary members

By that time, Mr. Loo established the Kwong Hon School in Kowloon with the main object to furnish the students with, in Canton and Macao. bigh education and military training. His object was favorably approciated by the Chinese community and many schools such as the Tai Yok School, the Yok Ying School, the Chi Yung School, the Ho Kut Po School, the Mok Lai Che School, the Lai Chi School, the School, the Lai Che School, and the Ellis Kadoorie School, by which he was offered respectively the position of a teaching stan. Mr. Lee recarried to Canton and became a student in the Public Medical College, when he was twenty four.

After the Chinese Republic was established, Mr. Lee returned to the Colony and set himself in the business field. was Treasurer of the Bank of Canton, and later promoted to the position of assistant manager. He was connected with this bank for twenty four years until it was re-organized in 1936. At present, he is general manager of the Shanighai Fire & Marine Insurance Co., Ltd. Besides this, he has been president and treasurer of the South China Athletic Association; director of the Shui Fung Cotton Co., Ital.
