

Mr. LAW YAN PAK, B.A.

Mr. Y. P. Law is a native of Sunwoi District, Kwangtung Province, and was born in Canton in 1888. He received his early education from private tutors and also attended for a few months at the Ellis Kadoorie School, (or the Honan College) Canton. In 1905 to 1912, he continued his studies in England, where he obtained his B.A. degree in the University of Cambridge in 1912.

In 1915, Mr. Law was appointed assistant master in the Education Department Hongkong. In the following year, he became acting Inspector of Vernacular Schools.

In 1919, he was appointed a member of the Board of Examiners and concurrently Supervisor of the Vernacular Teachers' Classes of the Technical Institute. In the following year, he was appointed Inspector of Vernacular Schools and was acting Head Master of Wanchai Government School.

From 1920 to 1924, he was Honorary Secretary of the Board of Education. From 1922 to 1925, he was Inspector of Vernacular Schools for the New Territtories.

Since 1925, he has been Senior Inspector of Vernacular Schools for Urban Districts, and an Ex-office Member of the Board of Education.
