

Dr. S. N. CHAU, M.B., B.S., D.O.M.S., D.L.O. (London)

Eye, Ear, Nose and Throat Specialist.

Dr. S. N. Chau, son of Mr. Chau Cheuk Fan, and cousin of the Hon. Mr. T. N. Chau, is the president of the Chinese Medical Association, Hongkong. Though a native of Tung-Koon, Kwangtung Province, he was born in Hongkong in 1903.

He matriculated from the St. Stephen College in 1918 and proceeded to the Hongkong University where he took up the Medical Course and graduated with the M.B., B.S. degrees in 1923. Then he proceeded to England and joined the London University, specialising in Eyes, Nose, Ear and throat work. He was appointed as Clinical Assistant at Royal London Ophthalmic Hospital and Central London Nose, Ears and Throat Hospital. Later, he qualified for the degrees of D.O.M.S. (eye specialist) and D.L.O. (Nose, Ear and Throat specialist).

With a view to further his studies in the above subjects he went to the State University of Vienna, from where he returned to the Colony in 1927 and started practice.

Dr. Chau is an influential figure in social affairs. He is a willing supporter of public welfare. From 1930 to 1935 he was lecturer in ophthalmology in the Holgkong University and ophthalmologist in charge of the Eye Clinic of the Government Civil Hospital. He is a member of the Urban Council and the Medical Board, Hongkong; Vice-president of Hongkong University, Medical Society; President of Chinese Medical Association, Hongkong; Hon. President of Confucian Society; Director, and Hon. Visiting Ophthalmologist of Hongkong Sanatorium and Hospital; Executive Committee of Tung-koon Chamber of Commerce; Hon. member and Executive Committee of General Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong; and Director of South China Athletic Association.
