Mr. Lo Wing Kit is a native of Sunwoi District, Kwangtung province, and was born in Hongkong in 1907. He came from a well-to-do family and had sufficient means to obtain a thorough education. He attained his primary studies in Hongkong and later he studied in Shanghai for a short period. Finally, he returned to the Colony and continued his studies in the St. Stephen's College. He remained there until 1932 when he graduated from the institution and in 1930 he started his commercial career in Shanghai as importer and Exporter. His conscientiousness and honesty enabled him to set a foundation in the business sphere, and two years later, he returned to Macao and was authorized by the Portuguese Government as the monopolist of opium in that city.

He returned to Hongkong in the following year and became compradore of the world-famed Nippon Yusen Kaisha Steamship Company. His experience and natural ability are valuable assets to the firm, and his integrity and innate courtesy endear him to all his business associates.

Mr. Lo is very active in social affairs. When he was in Macao, he was director of the Kang Wu Hospital and Vice-Chairman of the Chin Wu Athletic Association. Since 1936, he was appointed president of the Tung Wah, Kwang Wah, and Tung Wah East Hospitals. He is director of the Sunwoi Chamber of Commerce, Hongkong, and also of the Compradores' Association Hongkong.

Mr. Lo married in Yokohama in 1930 and has two daughters and a son.
